Intellidimension, a leading provider of Semantic Web technologies for the Microsoft®.NET Framework™ will be exhibiting at the SemTech 2010 Conference in June. At the exhibits the company will demonstrate the newly released version 2.0 of the Semantics Platform family of products featuring Semantics.Datacenter, a scalable solution to store, query, and perform inference over massive sets of distributed data. Semantics.Datacenter provides excellent performance for large user populations using key new features including; *Partitioned In-Memory Graphs* that leverage a proprietary technology designed to optimize RDF storage and querying, *Clustering* on multiple servers offering load balancing and high availability of data, and a *Jobs Framework* which provides highly parallelized processing of data on a cluster.

Version 2.0 of Semantics.Datacenter was benchmarked at 5 times the speed of competitive offerings using the Berlin SPARQL Benchmark 100 Comparison (as of 5/25/10).
